

Who we are!


EIDD - Design for All Europe is a European network, founded in Dublin, Ireland in 1993 with the name of European Institute for Design and Disability.

Mission


- Create and share the most interesting, actual, innovative and highly qualified Design for All contents, practices and ideas in Europe

To build bridges between members of the design community and other communities where *Design for All* can make a real difference to the quality of life for everyone.




EIDD Objectives
